Portfolio Submission Guidelines for Non-JUPAS, SETDAS (local)
and SETDAS (NLNM) Applicants
(2026 Entry)

The University regards the portfolio as an important vehicle enabling applicants to systematically document and showcase their prior experiences or works that reflect their creativity, enthusiasm, and resolution in heading toward a particular direction. Your admission to the programme is contingent on **both** your academic achievements **and** your portfolio.

Please note that your portfolio should consist of **TWO** major components:

1. **Representative materials** that exhibit your creative capabilities, innovative attempts, enthusiastic practices, and dedication to particular areas of interest. Such materials include but are not limited to:

- STEM/ STEAM projects
- Competition certificates (awards, participation, etc.)
- Business proposals
- Creative works (inventions, writings, drawings, sculptures, etc.)

** For three-dimensional objects, it is strongly advised that you take **more than one picture** of them from multiple angles.*

** For time-based materials (e.g. videos), their length should not exceed **5 minutes each***

2. **A personal vision statement** that identifies and outlines your goals, both short-term and long-term, your ambitions, your plans, and your strengths. Your statement should centre around **at least three** of the following questions:

- What is/ are the problem(s), global or regional, that you find particularly serious and most pressing and therefore would like to address? What piques your interest in the problem(s) in question?
- Why do you want to pursue a personalised learning pathway?
- What do you expect from pursuing a personalised learning pathway?
- Keeping in mind the problem(s) you aim to solve, what do you plan to do after university?
- What qualities or strengths do you hope to gain or develop from a transdisciplinary education?

* *The personal vision statement should **not be longer than 1000 words**.*

Submission guidelines

1. All materials to be submitted (both the representative materials and personal vision statement) should be merged into ONE Word or PDF file.
2. The entire file should be kept below 50MB in size.
3. Name the file using the applicant's Application Number before submission.
For example: If the application number is N24456789, the file should be named N24456789.pdf / N24456789.docx)
